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“Artwork can be either a focal point or an accent depending on the space. I typically bring in artwork during an installation once the furniture is placed in order to complete a room. Since artwork can look totally different in a gallery than it does in a painted room with different lighting, I will often choose a few different pieces to try in one spot to see which works best. Usually, I will place the more important or expensive artworks in the more prominent locations. This just makes sense as most clients really want to show-off their best pieces in their nicest rooms. I've had a few clients that already have established art collections with very significant pieces, such as Picasso, so those are obviously pieces that I will automatically work around. Just like our varied clients, I enjoy various styles of artwork – from the old masters, oil paintings, landscapes, modern sculpture, sketches, photography, and even to graffiti art. It really depends on the scale and style of the space and, of course, the clients' tastes.”
