[1] In a sophisticated yet playful dining room in a historic Florida bungalow, designer **RICHARD KEITH LANGHAM** finished the ceiling with a coral-and-white handmade paraplue. Sconces with coral and sea horse motifs flank the window.

[2] Designer **BARBARA WESTBROOK** upholstered the backs of traditional chairs in a graphic floral fabric for a youthful drama; the table skirt is just a shade lighter than the gray-brown walls.

[3] Designer **KIM ZIMMERMAN** found inspiration for her entire apartment in the Elsa Schiaparelli prints that hang behind her dining table. She kept the vibrant pink mats of the prints from appearing too heavy by topping two with white mats, leaving a trace of pink beneath. A white-painted pedestal table and a collection of chairs keep the space youthful, elegant, and chic.
